Levels of service:

- A Level- 35 IEPs maximum (0.029 FTE)
- B Level- 34 IEPs maximum (0.042 FTE)
- C Level- 15 IEPs maximum (0.067 FTE)
- D Level- 8 IEPs maximum (0.125 FTE)

Calculating total caseload FTE:

Multiply the number of students by their corresponding FTE weight then add up the total. For example:

A teacher has:	10 A-level students		10 B-level students		5 C-level stu	dents	2 D-level students	
	X 0.029		X 0.042		X 0.067	X 0.12	<u>25</u>	
	= 0.29	+	= 0.42	+	= 0.335	+	= 0.25	=1.30 Caseload
